

2007 Wrap Up

Well the Snowy Ride is over for another year (for the entrants anyway), and we set a few records into the bargain. Some were set at the bar on Thursday night, yes Thursday, so much for the Snowy Ride being a one day event.

The final tally on the entries was 2834 which makes it the biggest Snowy Ride (by 322) since its inception in 2001. Every State was represented by larger numbers including NSW which had slipped a little over the past few years. Unfortunately the increased numbers did not help when it came to the two bikes raffled on the day as one went to Victoria and one to Queensland.

On the dollar side of things we don't have a final tally as yet but I can say it will be in excess of \$200,000 which will take the total for the ride over the seven years to over 1.5 million dollars. I am not going to lay claim to the largest ride in Australia there will be too many disputes on that, but what I will say is that I don't know of any other ride that has raised 1.5 million dollars for charity and has given away over \$300,000 dollars worth of bikes and other items in the process.
